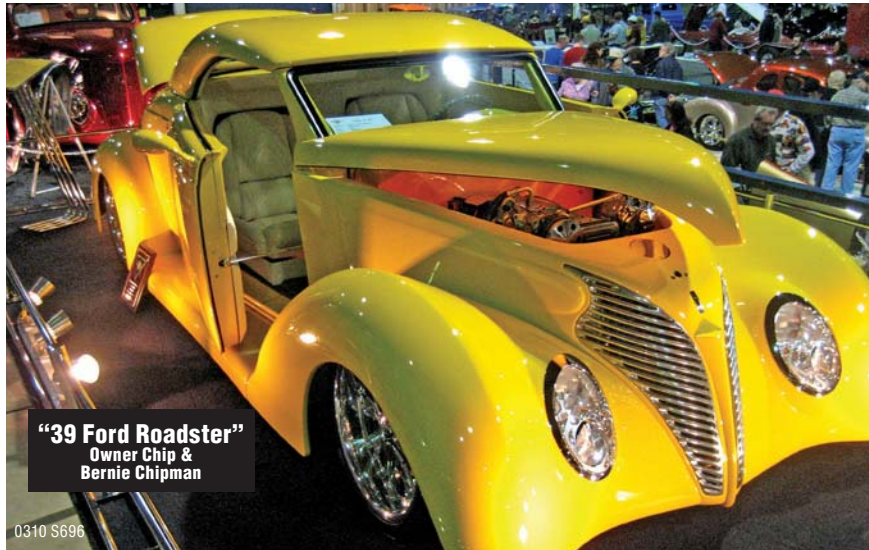
Please check the box if you need electrical hookup requirements.  Other special requirements—add explanation sheet.
