QUICK TIPS AND TRICKS

OL' FAITHFUL HURTING? Inner fender cracking? One fix is to form Conduit to the shape of the inner fender, clamp it to the inner lip and weld it along the inner lip edge. If you do not have a welder, you can run a row of sheet metal screws through the inner fender lip into the conduit. Be sure to start in the middle and work towards each end.

URGENT REGULATORY ALERT

SEMA has consistently voiced concern that (15%) ethanol increases water formation in the engine, which can create formic acid and corrode metals, plastics and rubber. EPA made the decision that older cars should not use fuels with E-15. But EPA, did issue an E-15 for use in 2007 and newer vehicles. The Ethanol Industry is pushing for ALL GASOLINE to be mandated E-15. Ethanol Distributors and stations would have to invest in new storage tanks, hoses, and other equipment. Auto owners would have to modify their engines. SEMA continues to work at stopping this increased ethanol content in gasoline.
